



Club Play at East Glos (formerly Social Play) Guidelines for players

Pegboard instructions

1. When you arrive put your peg at the end of the “waiting to play” section.
2. When you come off do likewise.
3. If you are at the front of the “waiting to play” section you must choose **four** people (including you) from the next **seven**.

Club Play is convenient and offers variety

You can come and go as when you want and play with lots of different people. However it can be made even more enjoyable for **all** by following some simple hints and tips.

Pegboard hints and tips

1. Try and aim for a sensible blend of skills, ie. don't put a relative beginner on court with three big-hitting, fast-serving players.
2. Don't just pick the next four waiting to play. Why not mix it up a bit to achieve a sensible mix?
3. If you're not sure who's who and what their standards are why not ask someone for some guidance?
4. If you see a new member who is not sure what do, please give them some help.
5. Don't worry if the genders aren't evenly matched. If the blend of skills is good it should not matter if it's three women and one man, or vice versa.
6. It can get tedious going on with the same people all evening no matter how well you all get on! Why not wait for a few minutes to mix it up a bit, there's bound to be someone arriving or coming off court soon.
